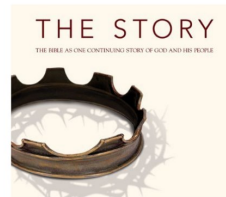

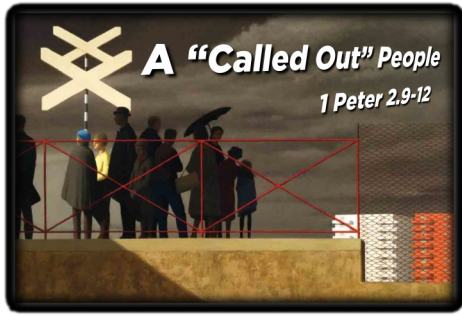

⁹But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for His own possession, that you may proclaim the excellencies of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light. ¹⁰ Once you were not a people, but now you are

God's people; once you had not received mercy, but now you have received mercy.

¹¹Beloved, I urge you as sojourners and exiles to abstain from the passions of the flesh, which wage war against your soul. ¹²Keep your conduct among the Gentiles honorable, so that when they speak against you as evildoers, they may see your good deeds and glorify God on the day of visitation.

In His sovereign purpose God equips a person for the task to which He calls him or her. Until I was 30, in 1990, I did not sense a palpable call of God to be a pastor. Yet God prepared me to be a pastor in 2022 by moving me to Adelaide, South Australia in 1971. Being "different" among a people with whom I shared the same language, education and culture has proved invaluable for pastoral ministry. Though long gone and possessing honey-colored memories dripping in nostalgia, nonetheless, I still carry the most important life lesson God taught me in Adelaide. What still rings utterly true after 50 years? Do not fear to stand apart. Do not fear to be different. Do not fear to be labeled. Do not fear to be excluded. Do not fear to explain yourself. Do not fear to be disbelieved ... or worse. Just ... do not fear.

Striving for acceptance from others is like climbing a greased pole. Pointless. A waste of time and energy. The church does not need the approval of the world. Striving after it is wasted effort. The church needs to embrace it's identity as "sojourners and exiles" in a fallen world. That's the gift we give to the world. We demonstrate **this world** is NOT all there is to life.
