Closing Doxology

Jesus between us ... from Matthew 18.15-20

15 "If your brother sins against you, go and tell him his fault, between you and him alone. If he listens to you, you have gained your brother. <sup>16</sup> But if he does not listen, take one or two others along with you, that every

charge may be established by the evidence of two or three witnesses. <sup>17</sup> If he refuses to listen to them, tell it to the church. And if he refuses to listen even to the church, let him be to you as a Gentile and a tax collector. <sup>18</sup> Truly, I say to you, whatever you bind on earth shall be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven. <sup>19</sup> Again I say to you, if two of you agree on earth about anything they ask, it will be done for them by my Father in heaven. <sup>20</sup> For where two or three are gathered in my name, there am I among them."

On the one hand, we love that last verse: "Where two or three are gathered ...". Whoo hoo! Jesus is with us in our smallest group. We don't need a crowd. We can be in our cars. We can be on the trail with a friend. Jesus is with us. Worship and fellowship can happen ... anywhere!

On the other hand, the text serves as a primer for community. Humility. Seeking after the lost sheep. Forgiveness. Authentic community is, also, the openness to confront your brother, the opportunity to gain your brother and the obligation to discipline your brother ... and all for the sake of maintaining community.

What? No "whoo hoo"? You mean authentic Jesus-centered community means expectations? accountability? willingness to exclude from community? In 2022? Say it ain't so!

Yep. Without Jesus-centered expectations, accountability and boundaries you won't have a Jesus-centered community. You may have a crowd. It might even be a fun crowd.

But Jesus won't be there.
