

BEING A MAN OF GOD

Our presenter, Sam Richbart, is known to many at PCC through his joyful service with Camp Hickory Hill. In 1986 Sam was made the Summer Camp Director. Sam continued to serve as the Camp Director and beginning in 1992 also served as the Regional Director for CSB Ministries until 2008 when he was brought on as the Executive Director for Camp Hickory Hill. Sam and Suzanne attend Randall Baptist Church in Williamsville, NY, where they are involved in a variety of ways. They have 4 grown children and 6 grandchildren.

Sam will lead three interactive sessions in an application of Psalm 37:

- Friday pm: The steps of man are established by the Lord
- Saturday am: A man of God not only grows older, but wiser in the Lord
- Saturday pm: A man of God equips his natural and spiritual children to bless others.

In between the morning and afternoon sessions, the Men are encouraged ... to relax. If relaxing means going for hike, then go for hike.
