## **Primary Roles & Responsibilities**

### **Strategy & Planning**

- Further develop the youth ministry vision and strategy along with the pastoral team and other youth workers as a vital component of the PCC overall ministry
- Plan, organize and lead a comprehensive youth ministry (6th-12th grade) involving youth group events, retreats, Bible studies, service and missions projects, etc.
- Coordinate with the Children's ministry leader to ensure all age groups have a common vision and thoughtful progression at PCC
- Seek out ways to integrate youth with the larger congregation and church ministries
- Develop relationships with individuals throughout the church body by becoming involved with church events and groups.
- Attend relevant leadership and committee meetings

### **Direct Responsibilities**

- Teach weekly youth group and teen Sunday school program
- Recruit, train and coordinate adult volunteers for teen programs
- Train youth leaders through discipleship and mentorship
- Provide counsel to youth and their families as needed
- Equip parents in their spiritual roles with their children at home, communicating with them through email and newsletters
- Submit and monitor budgetary needs and administrative details
- Report to the Senior Pastor and elder board, including for periodic reviews

**Qualification:** Preference will be given to applicants with a Bachelor's degree and significant prior experience working with youth

**Compensation:** PCC will offer a competitive package which includes salary, health and retirement. Compensation will be commensurate with education and experience.
